Why is the Torah special?

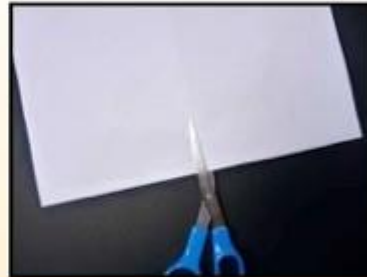
Help Sheet

How to make a Torah Scroll

You will need: A sheet of A4 paper, two cardboard tubes, two wooden sticks, sticky tape and scissors.



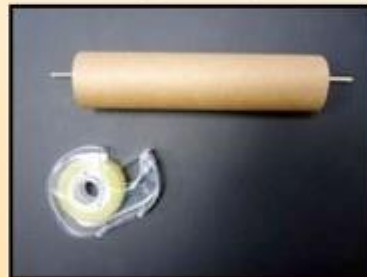
Take your sheet of A4 paper, fold and cut down the middle.



Use your sticky tape to stick the two pieces of paper together, giving you one long piece. This will become your scroll.



Use sticky tape to attach a stick inside your cardboard tube. Make sure your stick is longer than your tube.



Now it is time to assemble your scroll. Use your sticky tape to attach your paper scroll to your tube at either end.



Your Torah Scroll is now complete and ready for you to decorate!
