


#### Attendance every day counts.






#### Medical needs

#### Please consider applying for Pupil Premium:

Please check if you are eligible for Pupil Premium funding. If you are in receipt of certain benefits your child may be entitled to free school meals. More details can be found on the KCC website



Applications for funding such as this not only provides a school meal, but releases further funding which helps us to support individuals and groups of children in the school. If your child is in KS1 and you are eligible it is important that you apply. Although every child in these classes receive a Universal Infant Free School Meal, this will not automatically release other funding unless you apply for the Pupil Premium. If your child is currently in receipt of Free School Meals please do not apply.
