

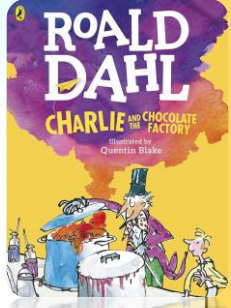
# Year 4 Term 6

### Green Religion - How should we care for the world, and why does it matter?

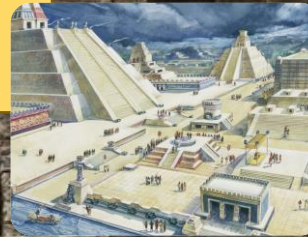
The children will be learning about different faiths' views on the environment, from worldviews, to Christianity, Islam and Hindu Dharma.

We will continue our learning about food, creating our own French café and serving our customers. We will also take a journey into France and Eurovision!



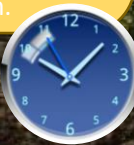
## Music
