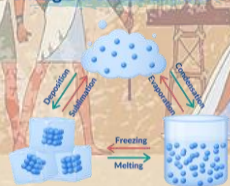


Year 4 Term 4



Change in states of matter



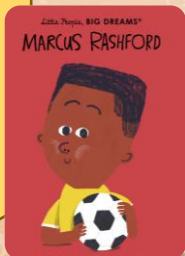
Science - States of Matter
The children will be exploring solids, liquids and gases; looking at and carrying out experiments into melting and evaporation.

RE - Salvation
Why do Christians call the day Jesus died Good Friday? We will be learning about The Last Supper and digging deeper into the events of Holy Week.



English - Little People Big Dreams Marcus Rashford

This term we will be writing biographies. Starting with Shakespeare we will then look at Marcus Rashford, before creating our own mini-booklets.



Art - Sculpture

The children will be designing and creating 3D sculptures using soap.



PSHE - Health and Wellbeing

This term the children will learn about dental health; think about a calm place that helps them to feel relaxed; describe about how they feel when they make a mistake and what can be learned from making mistakes; describe what makes them happy; understand what mental health is and that sometimes people might need help.

History - Ancient Egyptians

This term, we continue learning about the Ancient Egyptians - their gods, understanding hieroglyphics, understanding the significance and complexity of the pyramids and the Sphinx as well as looking at the discovery of Tutankhamun's tomb by Howard Carter.
